Comment:	Jean Hotteterre (died 1720) was a composer and musician of the Hotteterre family in the court of Louis XIV of France. He and his brothers Jacques-Martin and Nicolas made many enhancements to the hautbois, creating an indoor version similar to the shawm. Jean and Michel Philidore created the oboe. A minuet, also spelled menuett, is a social dance of French origin for two people, usually in 3/4 time. The word was adapted from Italian minuetto (more online)
